### TRANSCRIPTS

Certificates of Completion do not list your courses or grades. All visiting students will receive one complimentary Official Transcript of Grades mailed to the "Transcript Address" indicated at the time of registration. If you are unsure of your "Transcript Address" or did not indicate on your

application, you may verify and change it via TeleBears.

Additional official transcripts are issued by the Office of the Registrar. A link to the Office of the Registrar's page can be found by choosing "Transcripts" on the pull-down menu of "Registration" at the top of the Summer Sessions home page (<http://summer.berkeley.edu>). Any outstanding fees must be paid in full before a transcript can be issued.

#### **Include the following information on all orders:**

Name as registered, date of birth, SID number, dates of attendance, undergraduate or graduate record, signature, number of copies, mailing address for each transcript. Specify Rush or Regular processing, and a contact phone number for any questions or problems.
